Gender Identity Policy

We are a Christian School and believe that God made everyone, and that he loves everyone so much that he gave his only Son, Jesus, to die for us all, so that whoever believes in him, will not perish but will have everlasting life. We believe that God did not send his Son into the world to condemn anyone, but to save those who would believe in him.

We understand that not everyone sees the world the way we see it, and we respect the right for everyone to have their own perspective. We also believe that having a different perspective does not diminish how much people matter.

However, as Christian School, we have willingly associated together towards the common vision and objective of sharing the Gospel, and helping young people grow in accordance with the teachings of the Bible. We do this, because we believe the Bible is God's Word, and therefore is the supreme authority in wisdom and truth, and therefore completely trustworthy and good. Because we have accepted the Bible as God's Word, it informs and directs all of the values and practices of our organisation.

With regards to gender, we believe the Bible teaches:

1. That God creates people as male or female
2. That Male and Female are terms of biological identification based on dominant physical characteristics present at birth
3. That Sexual Identity or Gender Identity are terms that reflect a person's identity as male or female, as described above

The application of this shall be:

1. Student name and pronoun usage will correspond to their Sexual Identity as described above.
2. Student access to facilities, single-sex curricular and extra-curricular activities will be determined by their Sexual Identity as described above

Students shall dress in a manner that reflects their Sexual Identity as described above
